## **RULES FOR BALTIC RIDERS TOUR 2011**

## General

There will be four events included into the Baltic Riders Tour 2011:

2 to 5 of June 2011 Ruila CSI1\* (EST) 8 to 10 of July 2011 Saint Peterburg CSI2\* (RUS) 11 to 14 of August 2011 Incukalns CSI1\* (LAT) 26 to 28 of August 2011 Vazgaikiems CSI2\* (LTU)

There are four different classes in Baltic Riders Tour: 6 and 7 year old horses, junior riders, young riders and open class. Each class have three competitions per event:

6 and 7 years old horses 120/125 cm (first day), 125/130 cm (second and/or third day) Juniors riders 115 cm/120 cm LTU (first and second day), 120 cm/125 cm LTU (third day) Young riders 125 cm/130 cm LTU (first and second day), 130 cm/135 cm LTU (third day) Open class 135/140 cm (first and second day), 145 cm (could be named as Grand Prix)

Every event will have additional classes according to the events Schedule

Points from competitions on Sunday will be multiplied by 1.5. Eight best results from twelve competitions will be counted. If athlete starts with several horses, the best result will be taken in to account. In young horses class there is the competition between horses (not athletes). If there will be equal points in final standing the better result in Vazgaikiemis last day's competition will give the better place in final standing.

## **Prizes**

There will be prize money and/or prizes in kind according to events Schedules. Minimum prize money for 145 cm class is 10 000 Euros.

In young horses class will be prize money for the best five horses in tournament, special cups for three best horses and blanket for the winning horse and prize money of **600 Euros**:
