Nico Witte is known as the (former) owner of the famous stallion Jazz. He bought Jazz as a foal. Jazz is an outstanding breeding stallion and has now been given the Preferent predicate. Many of his offspring are performing at Grand Prix level and he is on the top of the dressage stallion breeding index.



Nico has a stable in the South of Holland. For many years he is very successful in breeding and buying foals and young horses, to be trained by his wife Madeleine Witte –Vrees, to be sold all over the world. Since a few years there is another dressage stable based on the same location. Nico's son Jeroen and his girlfriend Emmelie Scholten are running 'Trainings stable Witte – Scholten' on the same accommodation. They are specialised in riding young horses, of whom many approved stallions. This is not without success. Already 3 times Emmelie became World Champion with young horses in Verden. Just after her success at the championships in 2011, she also won nearly everything at the yearly national championships for young horses in Holland. With the 4 years old, she was number 1, 2 and 3 and she also won the 5 years old!

During the visit in Schijndel, Family Witte and Scholten will show the offspring of approved stallions, talented young horses and the training of the young stallions and horses up to Grand Prix level.
